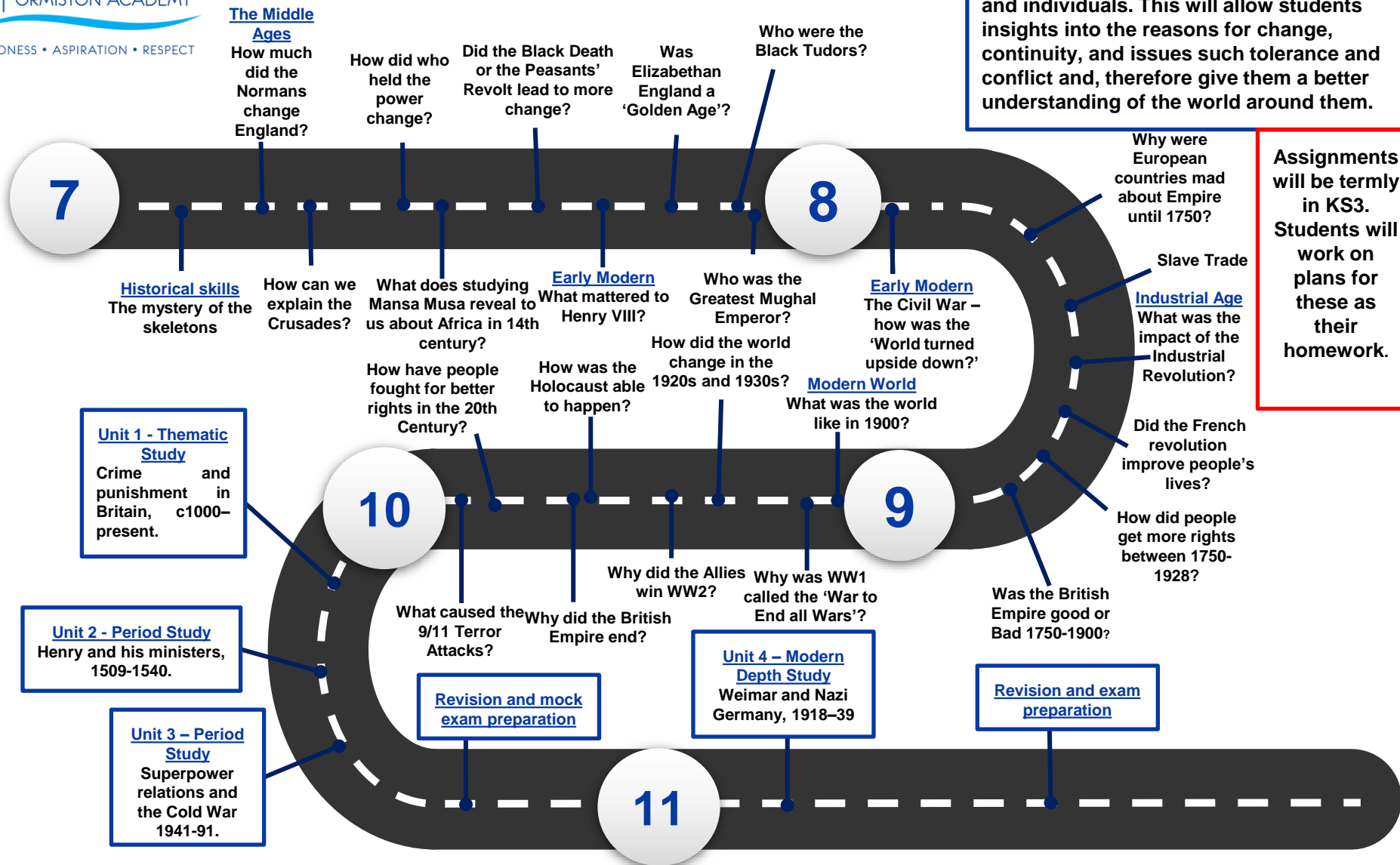


History Road Map
