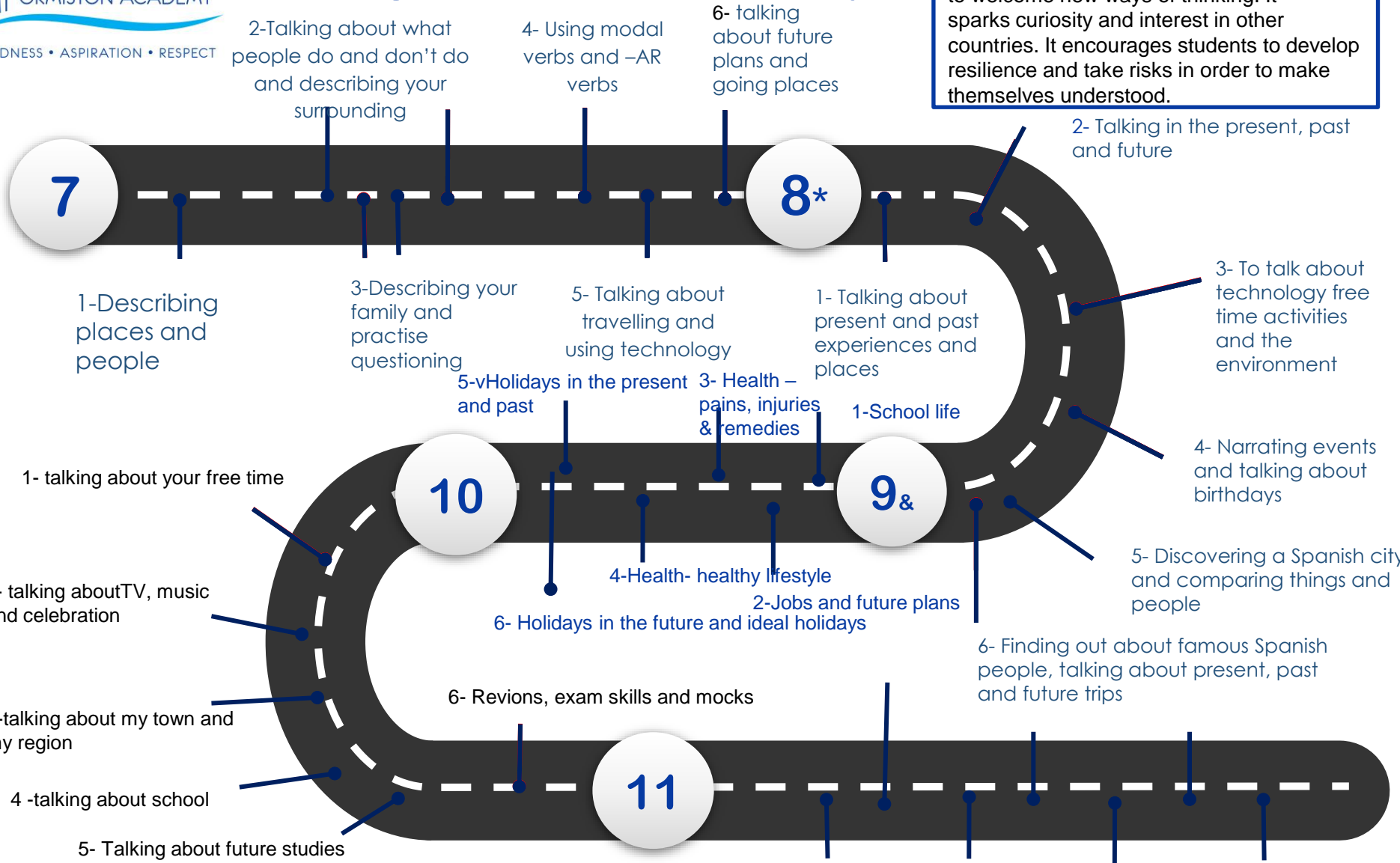


Subject Road Map

Yr 10 and 11 for 2022-2023 will be following the curriculum already in place for these years with some adaptations.
