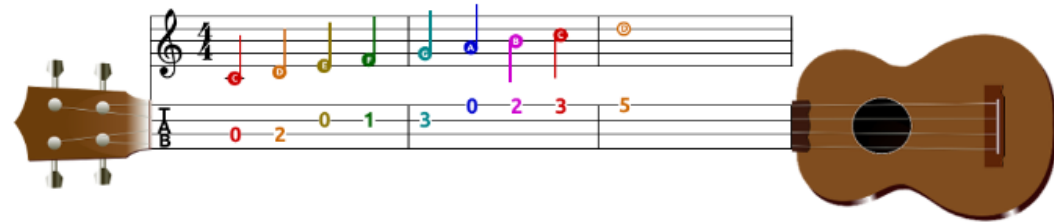


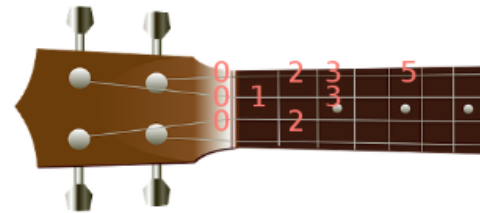
# Ukulele

## HOW TO READ UKULELE TABLATURE

The ukulele Tab(lature) is a timeline of notes to be pressed on various strings and frets. Each string is presented as a line on the Tab.



The number over a line represents the fret that needs to be pressed on that string; fret is the space between two metal bars on the neck.



0 (number) means that the string is played open, without pressing any fret.

The first note in the example above (low C) is played by plucking the 3rd string, open (no frets pressed).

The last note in the example above (high D) is played by pressing the 1st string on the 5th fret.
