We will continue to utilise the SchoolCloud platform for parents/carers to book appointments with subject teachers. You can access this booking page using the guidance provided:

- 2) On the academy website under the 'Useful links' section there is further guidance and a video to help.

This is a very important evening for you and one we value as an academy. Year 9 is an important year in which students get the opportunity to make choices about the qualifications that they wish to pursue in Year 10 and 11. We actively encourage students to be a part of the meetings with parents. To ensure that parents/carers are as confident as possible with the Options process, Mr Guy will be delivering three information presentations throughout the evening that we invite families to attend which can be booked through the online booking system. Our careers advisor Mrs Watson will also be available throughout the evening to discuss the options process and careers.
