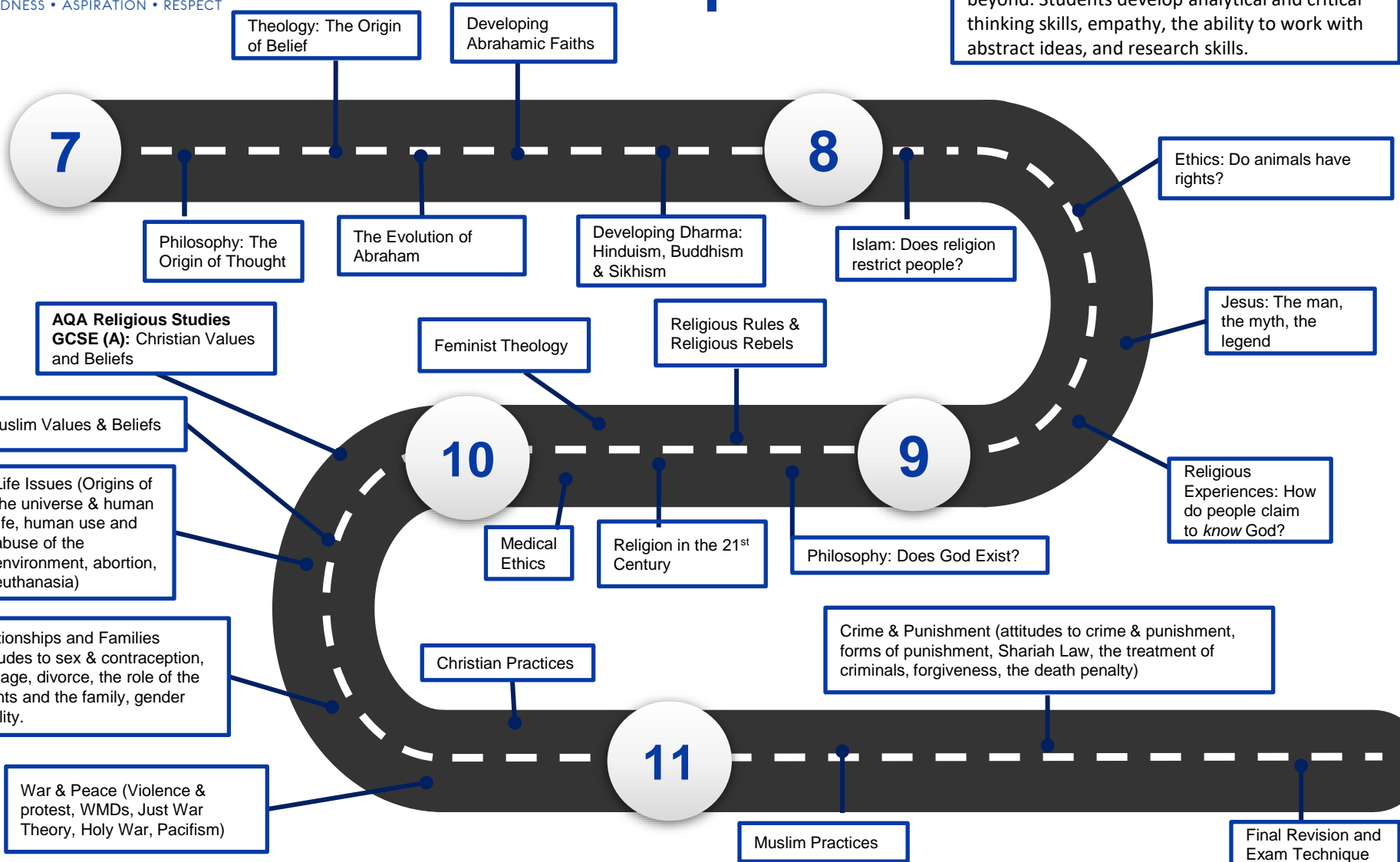


Religious Education Road Map
