I have included a letter at the end of this newsletter related to a consultation regarding our admissions policy. Although it's a minor change, we still need to go through the appropriate stages of consultation.


Use of Social Media







RE: Consultation on admission arrangements

Dear interested party,

I am writing to notify you of the upcoming consultation on the academy's admissions policy. The consultation period will run from 2nd October 2024 until 13th November 2024; during this time, parents are invited to express their views and any concerns about the proposed changes to the admission arrangements at Flegg High Ormiston Academy.

In accordance with the DfE's 2021 statutory 'School Admissions Code' guidance, as a school we must consult on our admission arrangements when changes are proposed, and at least once every seven years.

To this end, the following amendments to our admission arrangements have been proposed:

To remove the option of travelling to the academy on the Flegg minibus as this is no longer running due to budget constraints.

In accordance with statutory DfE guidance, the consultation will run for at least six weeks and, as an interested party at **Flegg High Ormiston Academy**, we are keen to hear your views on the <u>proposed</u> <u>change</u> therefore, we invite you to participate in the consultation if you have any concerns regarding the matter.

All responses to the consultation should be made in writing and submitted before <u>5pm</u> on <u>13th November</u> to: **Flegg High Ormiston Academy, Somerton Road, Martham, NR29 4QD or** principalsoffice@fleggoa.co.uk.

Please note that written responses should outline your personal details, including your name, address and relationship to the academy.

At the end of the consultation period, the governing board will meet to consider responses and submit a final policy to the Ormiston Academies Trust Board of Trustees for approval.
