We are looking forward to welcoming you in person to Year 9 progress evening and will be using the SchoolCloud platform for parents/carers to book appointments with subject teachers. You can access this booking page using the guidance provided:

This is a very important evening for you and one we value as an academy. We actively encourage students to be a part of the meetings with parents/carers as discussions around their performance and their KS4 options will be at the centre of each appointment with class teachers.

In previous years we have launched the options process at this event, however, we are currently undergoing a review of the curriculum offer and therefore, all information about the options process will be communicated, including video presentations in Spring half term 2. We will communicate with you once we have a clearer timeline.

Occasionally teachers are not available on the evening and therefore you will be unable to book an appointment on the booking platform. If this is the case, then staff will ensure they give feedback via phone or email following the evening. If staff no longer have availability as all their slots have been allocated, please add yourself to the waiting list and feedback will be provided via phone or email.

Appointments can be made from **6pm on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> January** and will close on Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> January at 4pm. Should you wish to make any changes after this date please contact the school office on 01493 740349.

We will also have members of the Senior Leadership, pastoral, attendance teams available throughout the evening. You will not require an appointment to talk to these staff members and we hope to have representatives from the local post-16 providers in the hall to talk to you too.
