Dear Parent/Carer,

Your child has now completed their last full term as a high school student and it feels like a momentous occasion! We would like to congratulate them on their fantastic effort in the February mock exams where because of their hard work we saw a significant movement in their grades, especially in English. We know that with this continued effort, together will see fantastic achievements this summer.

In order to support your child's continued progress, we issued them with their latest revision guide this week which takes them up to the 5th May.

In the lead up to the exams, we are asking you for your support for your child in a different way. In our final assembly before their exams, we would like to give each student a letter from yourselves telling them how proud of them you are and wishing them luck for the exams. Please don't discuss this with your child as we hope to use this as a surprise to them in the assembly.

Then on Thursday 1st May, we are inviting you in for an information evening, students will have an additional maths and English revision session from 3.15-5.15. Meanwhile, there will be a parent presentation from Mr Guy and Mr Richards regarding the exam series. At 5:15, students and families will join for a BBQ until 6pm. We will send out an invitation form shortly after the holidays so that we can plan for catering.

At this stage of year 11, it would be expected that students are completing a minimum of 1.5-2 hours of revision per day and this is something they should aim to continue with across the Easter holidays. With that in mind, the revision guide has been given to students with specific tasks for them to complete in each subject to support their revision. Each revision task is posted in the Year 11 Teams group so students have access to a fully resourced revision schedule. I have advised students that the most effective way for them to revise in the Easter holidays would be to revise early in the day so that their work is complete and they can then enjoy the rest of the day/evening.
