# Flegg High Ormiston Academy - Uniform and Expectations

At Flegg, we are committed to creating a positive and respectful environment where everyone feels proud to be part of our academy community. Our uniform and behaviour expectations help us all focus on learning, while promoting respect for one another. We are here to support you in meeting these expectations and ensuring that every day at school is a positive experience. **The below is a summary of the current uniform expectations.** 

## Uniform

**Blazer**: Our navy blue blazer with the academy logo is an important part of our school identity. It shows pride in being part of Flegg.

**Jumper**: A navy blue V-neck jumper with the academy logo (optional) can be worn for warmth and comfort.

**Shirt:** A light blue short or long-sleeved shirt is to be worn every day. It should be neat, tucked in, and ready for learning.

**Tie:** The two-tone blue tie is part of our uniform, and we ask that it is worn properly every day.

**Skirt:** If you choose to wear a skirt, it needs to be a navy blue 4 drop pleat 22" length skirt or longer to ensure skirt is knee length (can be purchased from either Harrisons or any other outlet but must look the same and meet the specification of being navy blue 4 drop pleat skirt that is a minimum of 22" in length). Skirts must not be rolled.

**Trousers:** Navy blue, tailored trousers should be worn. These should not be skinny or cropped styles, as we want all students to be comfortable and ready to learn.

**Shoes:** Smart black shoes (not boots or canvas style shoes) must be worn, ensuring comfort and support throughout the day.

**Socks/Tights:** Plain black, blue, or white socks or tights.





# PE & Dance Kit - NEW KIT FROM SEPTEMBER 2025

Please note that we will be changing our PE kit for the new year from September. This is currently available from Harrisons and students can begin transitioning over the summer term however we would ask that they will require the full kit and not singular items. Full details are on the website.

**PE Top (required):** New Flegg PE top available from Harrisons (this can be either polo or round neck)

**PE Socks (required):** Two tone blue socks available from Harrisons.

**Sports Shorts (required):** Plain Navy-blue sports shorts (from Harrisons or other retailers) will keep you comfortable during PE and dance.

**Trainers (required):** Any comfortable pair of trainers are fine for PE activities.

**Rugby Top (optional):** For rugby, we wear the two-tone blue rugby top to show our spirit and teamwork.

**Tracksuit Bottoms (optional):** Optional navy blue tracksuit bottoms for colder weather or outdoor activities.

**PE Sweatshirt/Waterproof Jacket (optional):** Optional but useful for outdoor PE or when it's chilly.

# **Outer Garments**

**Coats & Jackets:** Coats and Jackets can be worn over uniform but must be removed in classrooms. Hoodies are not part of our uniform, and we ask that they are removed when at the academy.

**Hats & Scarves:** These are fine for the colder months, but should be removed when indoors.

# **General Expectations**

Uniform should be worn with pride and in line with our academy values, ensuring everyone feels part of our community.

All items should be clearly named to help us return anything that may be misplaced.

No extreme hairstyles or makeup - we want everyone to focus on their learning without distractions.

Jewellery should be kept simple – we only allow one small pair of stud earrings.

We understand that sometimes things can go wrong, and if you need support with any part of your uniform, please don't hesitate to speak to us. We are here to help you and will always work with you to ensure you can follow the uniform expectations comfortably.

We believe that by following these guidelines together, we can create a respectful and focused environment where everyone can thrive.
