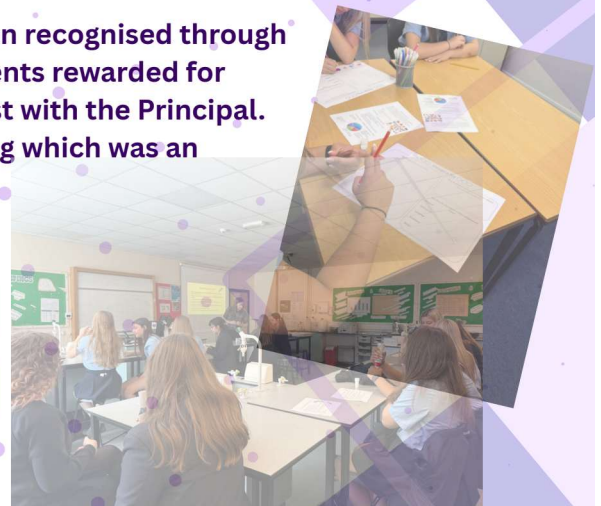
College Clash Champions!

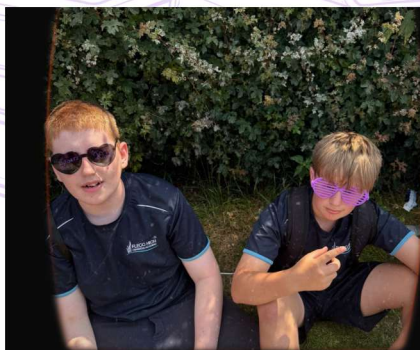
Student Voice Matters

Aspire students enjoyed a trip to the Apollo Theatre to watch a performance of Wicked.

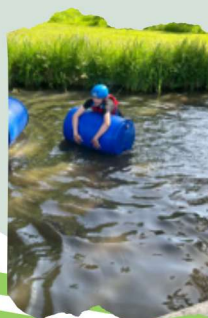

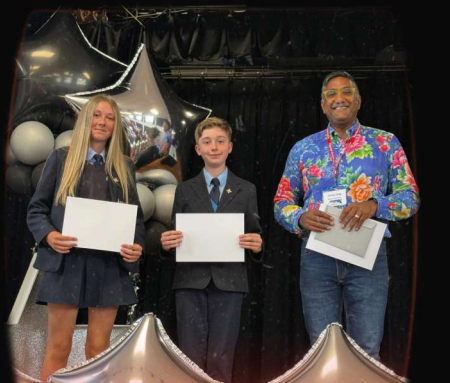

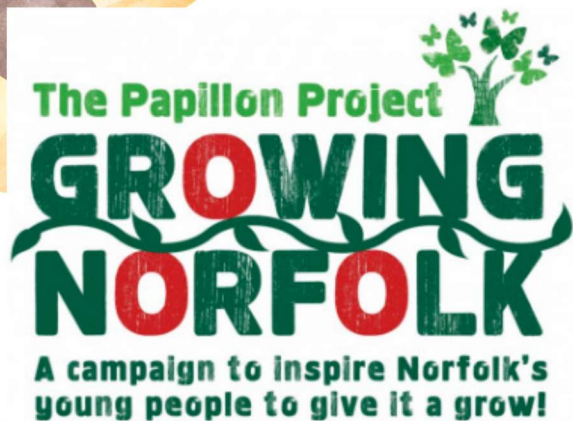
